Joseph and Rebecca Meyerhoff Auditorium

The Joseph and Rebecca Meyerhoff Auditorium is an elegant venue for concerts, screenings, business presentations, dance showcases and theatrical performances. Located on the second floor of the East Lobby, the auditorium is equipped with film and digital projectors, industry-quality professional sound and lighting systems, a stage suited for dance and theatrical performances, piano and portable Marley dance floors, and access to dressing rooms for performers.

Availability: Monday through Sunday, day and evening

Rates listed are for rentals up to 4 hours and include security and one lead AV technician. There is a fee for each additional hour.

Please note – Food and beverage is permitted in the auditorium with restrictions. Beverages may be served only in lidded plastic containers. Red wine/dark liquids are NOT permitted, but coffee is lidded to-go containers is allowed. Contained snack foods (candy, cookies, etc.) may be served, but open plates, to-go meals and popcorn are NOT permitted.

East Lobby

A contemporary atrium space with stylish internally-lit bar, Italian marble staircase and Venetian plaster walls. Perfect for cocktail receptions, wedding ceremonies or intimate dinners. Please note – if using both levels of the lobby red wine/dark liquids/dark foods are NOT permitted. Red wine is permitted when using only the first floor of the lobby.

Capacity: Seated meal 100; Standing reception 350; Seated wedding ceremony 50 – 100

Availability: Monday/Tuesday anytime; Wednesday and Thursday 6pm-10pm

Note: This space is NOT available to rent on weekends

Rental Fee: \$3,000 (\$2,000 with Auditorium rental)
